Nurses Christian Fellowship International ***ROLE OF NEXT GENERATION CONTACT PERSON ON*** ***NCFI REGIONAL COMMITTEES***

NCFI has a forum for students and young nurses/midwives called the Next Generation (NG) where people can join a monthly prayer group online and meet students and young nurses/midwives from all over the world. Some have met through NCFI's conferences and/or congresses, and others have never met each other face to face, but still they gather online and pray together.

Students and young nurses/midwives can find the NG contact person for each region at www.ncfi.org and learn more about who they are and how they work.

Role and responsibility of the NG Regional contact person

- a. The NCFI NG contact person in each region, is appointed for 2 years by their NCFI regional committee. The same NG person can be appointed three times, serving a total time of 6 years.
- b. The NCFI NG contact person in each region can be a member of the regional committee or just be a contact person who communicates on a regular basis with the chairperson or one of the members of the NCFI regional committee.
- c. The NCFI NG contact person in each region has a coordinating role for students and young nurses/midwives within that region.

The NG contact person compiles a database of contact information received -either from students or young nurses/midwives themselves or from their local NCF.

NOTE: The storage and use of the database must be in accordance with the NCFI privacy policy.

- d. The six regional NG contact persons plan and share responsibility for monthly prayer meetings across regions. The event will be announced on Facebook at NCFI NG. The prayer group uses google hangout or Skype to connect, so to connect, a person will have to add the gmail-account and/or skype name.

To join the prayer group, the students and young nurses/midwives must “like” the page, and send the NG contact for their region a message telling him/her who they are, where they live, and what they do, and if they are a student or if they work as a

- nurse/midwife. The NG contact person also needs to know if the students or young nurses/midwives are connected to a local NCF group, or if they would like to join one.
- e. The six regional NG contact persons are in contact with one another on a regular basis to exchange information and support each other.
 - f. The six regional NG contact persons appoint who is/are responsible for updates and development/maintenance of the NG Facebook site.
 - g. The six regional NG contact persons appoint who is/are responsible for sending relevant information regarding NG to the Media and Communication person in NCFI so relevant information can be posted on the NCFI website and NCFI Facebook page.
 - h. The regional NG contact person may be consulted for planning of regional and international conferences to ensure a student/early career focus is taken into consideration.
 - i. The six regional NG contact persons are not responsible for organizing conferences or teaching events for students and early career nurses/midwives.
 - j. The regional NG contact persons are not responsible for organizing new establishment of NCF-groups within a country that does not have one. If this is desirable, they will forward the request to NCFI.
