FCN Nigeria has an active program, featuring an annual National Conference, a Missions Conferences, and student conferences for Next Generation nurses. The 2025 National Conference for FCN Nigeria will be held in Lokoja, Kogi State, North Central Nigeria between 11th - 15th August, 2025.

FCN's theme for the current year is, "Making Difference Count in Nursing Practice".

NEXT GENERATION

The leadership of FCN Nigeria conceived a vision to develop a viable and sustainable FCN students' ministry through encouraging commitment of Christian students and young registered nurses and midwives to meet the overall goal of "Nurturing the Next Generation of members of FCN Nigeria". This mandate was achieved in June 2012 with the hosting of the maiden FCN National Students (Next Generation) Conference. The conference subsequently became an annual event.

This year, the annual conference of all the Next Generation members will also be hosted in four designated centers in Nigeria on the last weekend of May, 2025.

NATIONAL INSTITUTE FOR CHRISTIAN NURSING

Projects being implemented address health education programmes, health care delivery services, care and support, and orphans and vulnerable children services through community health, reproductive health, medical missions, HIV counseling and testing, and capacity building activities.
